## Current Projects

### Ashley Reservoir – Electric

Location	Ashley Reservoir, between pump station and railroad (For more information: <a href="https://www.hged.com/news/2022/12/ashley-22.aspx">https://www.hged.com/news/2022/12/ashley-22.aspx</a> )
Description	Required transmission line maintenance
Impact	Tree crews will remain working in the reservoir but walking path is now open. Please avoid any coned off areas during the hours of 7AM-3PM, Monday through Friday, weather permitting (excluding holidays)
Duration	Expected Completion Date: 3/31/23

### Canal Outage - Hydro

Location	Downtown Holyoke - 1st, 2nd, 3rd level canals
Description	Annual Spring Canal Outage
Impact	During this time, the canals are drained for inspection and maintenance.
Duration	Expected duration: 3/21/23 to 3/23/23

### Lincoln St Area - Electric

Location	Lincoln St and side streets
Description	Overhead Electric upgrades
Impact	One lane traffic
Duration	Expected Completion Date: 3/31/23

### Tree Trimming- Electric

Location	Various – Storm clean up County Rd - from Dupuis to Southampton Road Apremont & Rock Valley
Description	Tree Trimming – Asplundh Tree
Impact	One lane of traffic
Duration	Expected Completion Date: 3/31/23

**South Street - Gas**

Location	South St (from Brown Ave to Northampton Street)
Description	Gas Main and Service Relocation
Impact	<p>Customer’s gas service will be interrupted for approximately 4-6 hours while HG&amp;E replaces the piping from the gas main to the gas meter. Parking signs will be placed on the side of the road at the end of each day to keep the target work area open for the next morning.</p> <p>Throughout this project, HG&amp;E will maintain one lane of traffic as much as possible. In order to complete the project, there will be times HG&amp;E will have to close the road and implement a detour.</p>
